


4 ways to get here

Many tours from many cities! Book Limon Bus!






Parking MAP

Playing in the Snow Land

Rental & Shop

Wear and Snow Boots can be rented.
Beanie and Gloves can be bought at the
bottom station shop "Biwako Street".

Bottom Station

Purchase a ropeway ticket.
Hold the ticket all the time.

Ropeway

Enjoy a 5-minute ride in the air to the
Summit Station.

Snow Land

Buy a ticket at the Snow Land entrance and
play with various equipment including sledge.

Safety and Etiquette

For warmth and safety, always
put on your wear, beanie,
boots and gloves.

Keep Snow Land play
equipment inside.

Sledging is possible only inside
the Snow Land.

Only skiers and snowboarders
are allowed inside the courses.



Skiing and Snowboarding

Rental & Shop

Ski, Snowboard, Boots, Wear, Goggles,
Helmets can be rented. Beanie and
Gloves can be bought at the bottom
station shop "Biwako Street".

Bottom Station

Purchase a lift ticket (Ropeway ticket
included). Hold the ticket all the time.

Ropeway

Enjoy a 5-minute ride in the air
to the Summit Station.

Ski Hill

Enjoy skiing and snowboarding. The
lifts can be taken limitless. Present
lift ticket upon getting on.



Ski & Snowboard School

For lesson, go to school reception
desk at the summit station.



Safety and Etiquette

Only skiers and
snowboarders are
allowed inside the
courses.

Stop at the side of
the course.

Keep away from
snow groomer.



Attach a leash cord to
the snowboard.

Put on your wear,
beanie, goggles and
gloves for safety.

Follow the signs/Do
Not Enter to Keep
Out Area.



Place ski and
snowboard on the
rack outside the
building upon
entering.

Remember your
equipment number
and be sure to take
your own one
from the rack.
