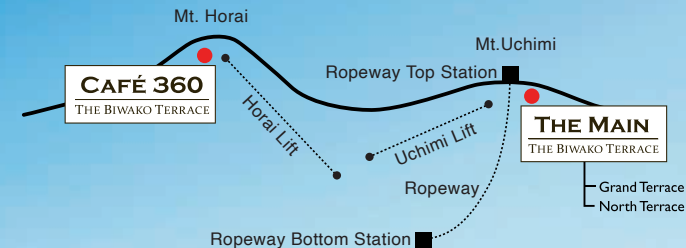

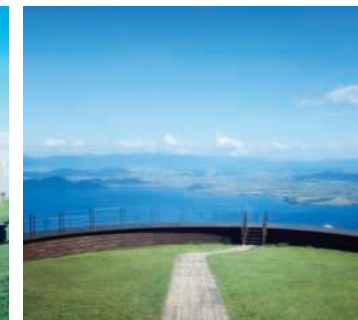

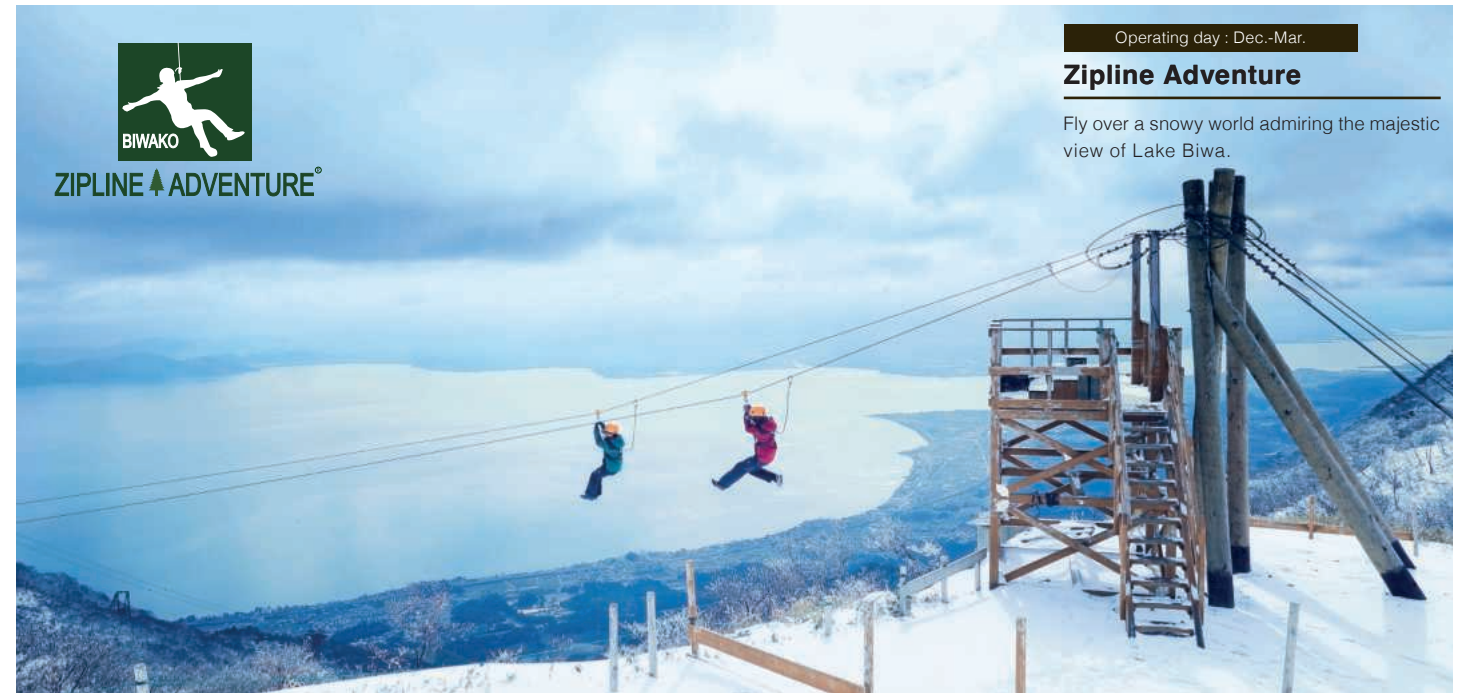
Snow Land

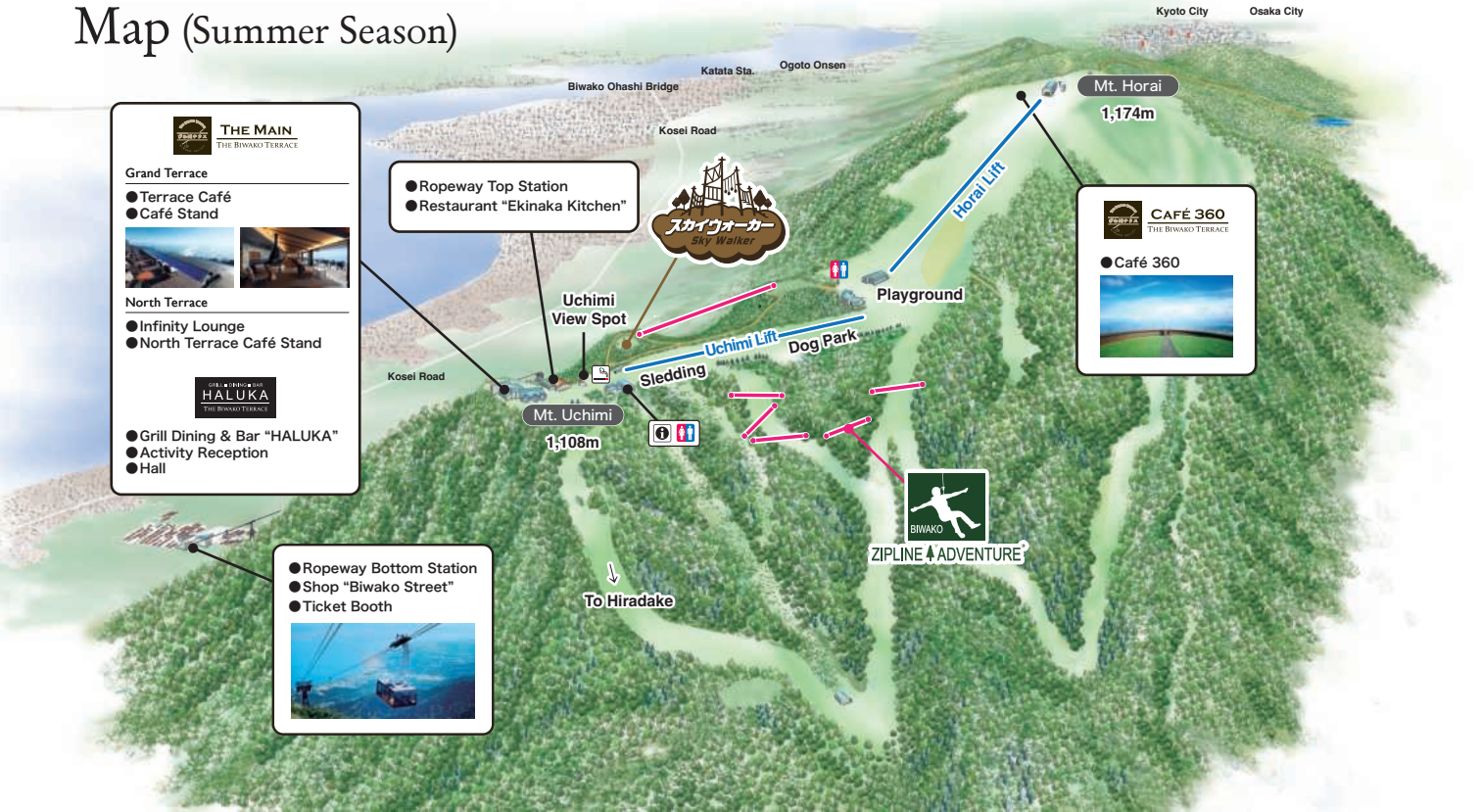

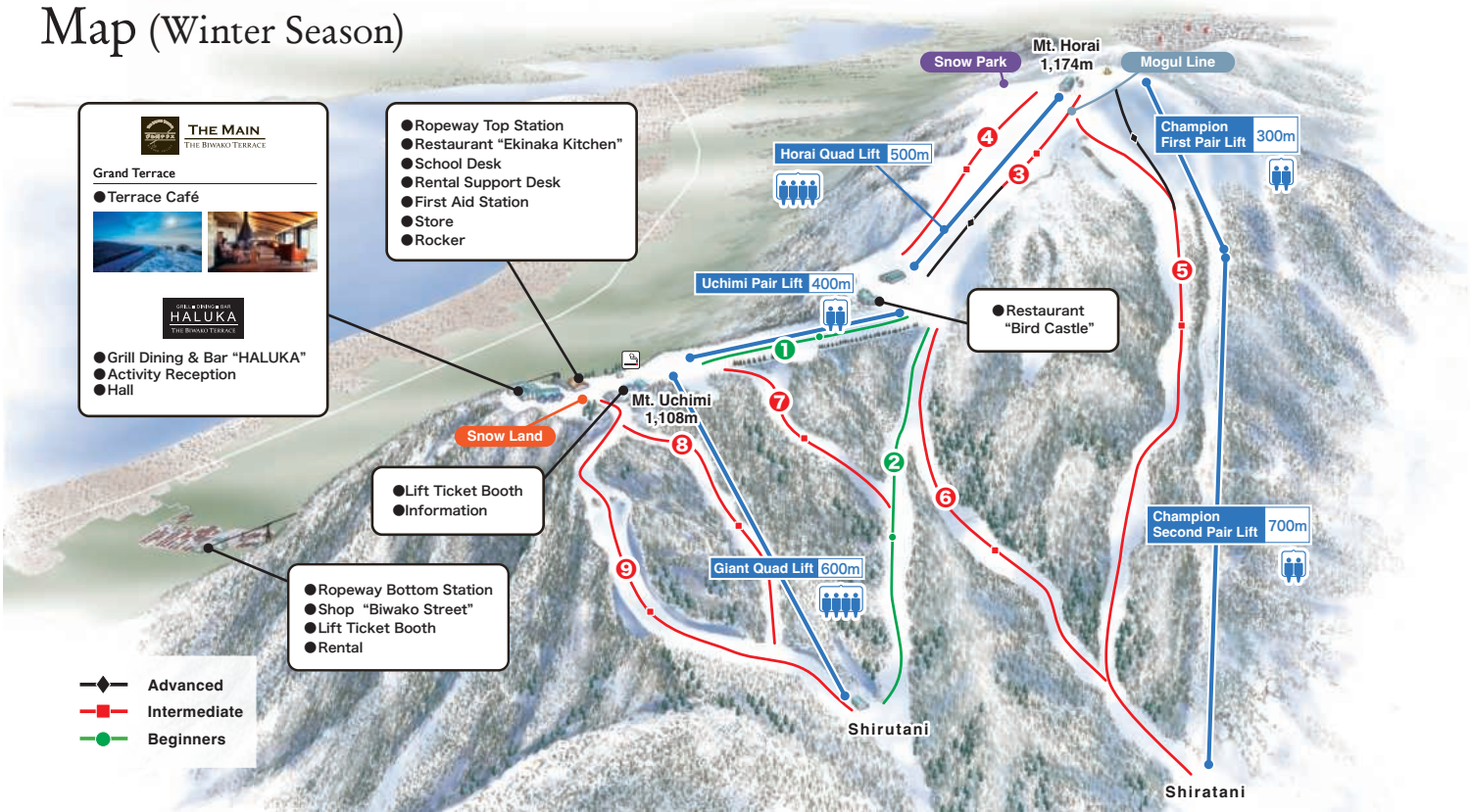
