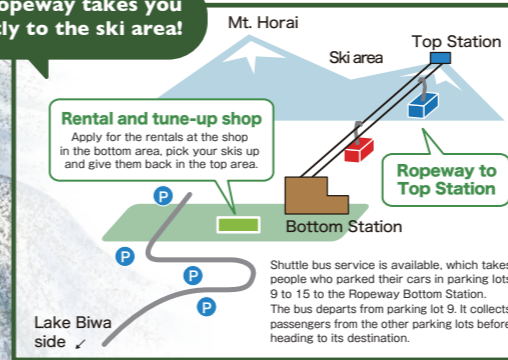

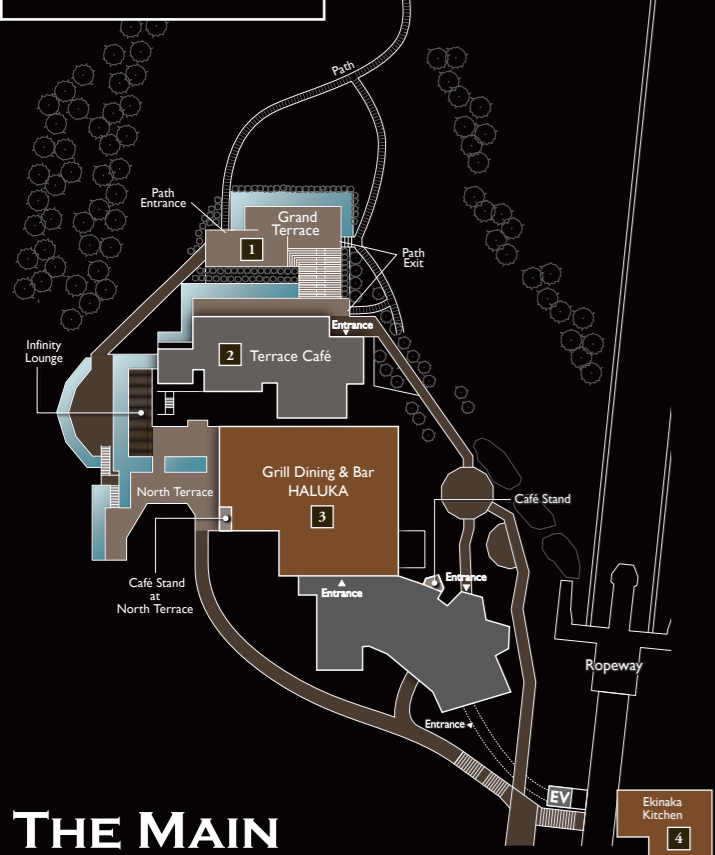
1 Grand Terrace THE MAIN THE BIWAKO TERRACE
